Dear Parents/Guardians,

If your child is in reception they are going to be angels and will need to be provided with an angel costume. If your child is in year 1 they are going to be sheep and will need to be provided with a sheep costume. Recommendations are detailed below for the year 2 speaking parts.

If your child is in year 2, an additional letter has been sent home by Miss Wilson with their allocated part for the show.

We also have a box of spare nativity clothing to browse through in school if you would like help with your child's costume - feel free to come in and have a look!

Please could you send your child's clothes in a clearly named carrier bag and ensure all items inside the bag are named too. We would like these to be brought in on Friday 30th November please (or earlier) and will keep them in school until the end of all the performances.

Character Costume Suggestions

Character	Costume Suggestions
Narrators	White gown with costume trim
Innkeeper's Wife	Long tunic, headdress and apron
Cat	Black or brown onesie, ears on a headband, tail and face-paint
Dog	Brown or spotty onesie, ears on headband, tail and face-paint

Ox	Brown onesie, long horns on a headband, tail and face-paint
Camels	Beige onesie, ears on a headband, tail, face-paint and long lashes
Sheep	Wooly fleece with hood, black leggings, tail and face-paint
Donkey	Grey onesie, long ears on headband, tail and face-paint
Innkeeper	Tunic and apron
Mary	Traditional blue tunic and headdress
Joseph	Traditional tunic, cloak and headdress
Shepherds	Traditional tunic, cloak, headdress, a beard and crook
Angels	White gown with tinsel, tinsel halo and wings

These are only suggestions so please don't feel restricted. You can be as creative as you like!
