Project

Our project for this term is a history topic 'Ancient Egyptians'. We are going to be finding out about: their civilisation and compare it to Britain at the time; learn about Egyptologists; the rulers of Ancient Egypt, their dynasties, battles and burials; and the significance of Ancient Egyptian tombs and how their discoveries and helped us to learn about their lives.

Reading

We will have daily quiet reading sessions, so please make sure children have their diaries and books in their bags **every day**. Please, please, please wherever possible, read with your child everyday at home. It is the single thing which makes a MASSIVE difference to their confidence, achievement and ability to access learning in the classroom- even when they are in Year 5 and 6! We will be awarding certificates to the top two children who have the most reading recorded in their diary, or who have spent time writing a book review.

SMART

Please remember to make use of the SMART apps for which we pay the children's subscriptions. DoodleLearning has four separate apps: DoodleMaths, DoodleEnglish, DoodleSpell and DoodleTables. The children's DoodleLearning login is the same for all the apps, and they're all great to help fill any gaps. We will celebrating children who are in the green zone on their DoodleLearning every Friday as an extra incentive to be SMART!

The children's Oddizzi login this year is thereef and the password is the same. They can also use TT Rockstars to practise their timetables too.

Swimming

We will all be swimming on Monday 9th September for an assessment and then any children not reaching the National Curriculum requirements will continue to swim until they reach the standard required for them to be safe.
